

<Textbook> Green, Red, Yellow, and Blue books

Green book :

What can you do? ⇒ I can touch the red circle / yellow square etc. (Asking and answering)

(「何ができる？」の質問と、それに答える練習をします)

Let's play. ⇒ OK! Let's play ball, tag, jump rope.

(「Let's ○○」のフレーズの練習をします)

Point / Go to the board, table etc.

(「Point」と「Go」の動詞を使う練習をします)

Red book

What do you want? ⇒ I want a new toy / big book etc.

(「何が欲しい？」の質問と、それに答える練習をします)

Do you want a yellow bicycle? ⇒ No, I don't. I want an orange bicycle.

(質問に対する否定の答え方とその後につける文の練習をします)

What's your favorite color? ⇒ Red. What about you? ⇒ I like blue etc.

(質問した相手に同じ質問をするフレーズを学びます)

I walk the dog every day. / I don't walk the dog every day.

(定期的に行う又は、行わない行動のフレーズを学習します)

Yellow book

What's he/she doing? ⇒ He/She's walking, fishing, reading etc.

(主語が単数の場合の現在進行形の使い方の練習をします)

What are they doing? ⇒ They are playing soccer, cooking etc.

(主語が複数の場合の現在進行形の使い方の練習をします)

What's he eating? ⇒ He's eating pancakes etc

(現在進行形を使って質問し、それに答える練習をします)

Do you ever play outside, take a bath, look at stars etc. at night? ⇒ Yes, I do. / No, I don't. (句動詞を学びます)

Blue book

I work in a store. I sell things. What's my job? You're a salesclerk. (identifying an occupation from a description)

(いろいろな状況を説明して、何の職業なのかを明らかにします)

Reading & questions practice : p63.

(読解問題に取り組みます)

Which sports (etc.) do you like? ⇒ I like baseball and soccer.

(「which」の使い方を学びます)

Which sport do you like more? ⇒ I like soccer more. (comparing likes)

(「more」の使い方を学びます。「more」がある場合とない場合の違いを学びます)

Verbs : sleep, skate, stop, draw, cry, ride. (動詞)

Green & Red just vocab, and depending on class simple sentences. "I can ride a bicycle", "Let's draw a picture" etc.

(上記単語を覚えて、発音の練習をします。クラスによっては、簡単な文を学びます。)

Yellow & Blue students make their own sentences using vocab.

He's drawing a picture of a monkey. / He's crying because he dropped his ice cream. / Stop speaking Japanese in class! etc.

(上記の単語を使って文を作り、発音の練習をします)
